


**FESTIVAL GUIDE**



### 'TICKETS

Single tickets can be purchased either online or at our festival location EYE.

To buy tickets online, go to eyefilm.nl. The purchasing process is (unfortunately) only available in Dutch, but no worries, the KLIK! website offers a manual for non-Dutch speakers.

At EYE you can buy your tickets at the box office (Please note: As EYE does not accept cash. please don't forget your ATM card!).

Want to experience KLIK! at its IVE, IJPROMENADE 1 fullest? Get an Unlimited Pass TOREN. OVERHOEKS 1 for the whole festival or get a Day Pass for any festival day from Wednesday on.

Pass, you won't need to make reservations for individual screenings: The pass is your entry ticket.

You can buy your Unlimited or EYE. Day Pass at the KLIK! Website. During the festival you simply need to pick up your pass(es) purchased online at the KLIK! Desk.

"The significance of the animated film as a means of communication is best realized in terms of its flexibility and scope of expression," wrote John Hubley and Zach Schwartz, two influential artists of the idea.
