With proud hearts we welcome you to the 10th-anniversary edition of the KLIK Amsterdam Animation Festival.





FESTIVAL TRAILER



This year's festival trailer is an amazing trip down memory lane. In honor of our theme. Never Grow Up. KLOMP! Animation created a nostalgic homage to shows and films many of us grew up with and still have an impact on our lives, from Steamboat Willie to Looney Tunes, Pokémon, Transformers, Dragon Ball Z, The Lion King, and plenty of other classics. Main character

Klikbert the klikker runs through different styles and settings to finally make it to the KLIK Amsterdam Animation Festival. Pay close attention to see if you can spot all the tributes. The trailer is the result of collaboration between KLOMP! Animation, Colorbleed, Studio Plumeau, Elephant Ears, Kasper Werther, Hilde Buiter, Kabo Lam. and many others.

A DECADE OF KLIK

KLIK has always been about animation and fun, and over the past ten years we've had plenty of both. Having reached this milestone, we wanted to look back at KLIK's major highlights and hijinks.

2007 - The very first edition was actually called KLIT. It was a small, one-day affair with 250 guests who all got to feast on free cotton candy.

2008 - The festival changed its name to KLIK and sprawled out over three days.

2009 - KLIK had its first theme. or rather two: "Politics and Erotica." We also introduced our beloved klikker and hosted our first international tour to Russia. 2010 - KLIK grew to five days and hosted its first research symposium on the visualization of science.

2011 – In preparation of our big move to EYE, the festival organized a one-day KLIK special focused on the Dutch industry.

2012 - We had our grand debut at Eve. Adventure Time-creator Nate Cash was one of our

special quests, and an amazing Cardboard Animation Workshop ended in the legendary Cardboard Robot Dance-Off. 2013 - KLIK introduced the World Domination Award for Dutch animators on the path to global success, and Erik-Jan de Boer was the first recipient. 2014 - "Boys, Girls & Beyond" was the gender-bending theme, and guests included Pixar's Michael B. Johnson and Disnev's Dawn Ernster and Josh Staub. KLIK hosted an industry tour to LA. San Francisco, and Portland. 2015 - Special guests included Tomm Moore of Cartoon Saloon and stop-motion artist and Oscar-winning director PES. 2016 - Last year, the festival welcomed over 14,000 visitors. Highlights included our first big art exhibit and Michael Dudok de Wit being awarded the World Domination Award.


CONTINUOUS, EYE ARENA



Time to shoot some bad guys! In the EYE Arena you can play Cuphead, a run and gun video game released last month that's heavily influenced by 1930s cartoon characters like Betty Boop and Popeye. The visuals and audio were created with the same techniques of the era, such as hand drawn cel animation, watercolor backgrounds, and original jazz recordings.






