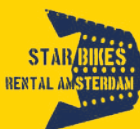

Kaboom and Kaboom Kids... what's the dif?

Kaboom Kids is the part of Kaboom Animation Festival that exclusively offers films, workshops, expeditions and interactive installations for families and kids. The kids' programming will take place from 9-12 November in Utrecht. Kaboom, on the other hand, takes place from 12-17 November at the beautiful Westergas in Amsterdam. Here we'll present the best animated shorts and feature films, VR experiences, inspiring talks by animation talent, and an extensive industry programming.

Can I bring my baby and/or pet to Kaboom?

You can bring your baby and/or monkey to the festivities, but our screenings are generally too noisy and confusing for humans under the age of three and little pet ears.

At Kaboom in Amsterdam, all programs are in English, unless stated otherwise. Films in other languages will have English subtitles. 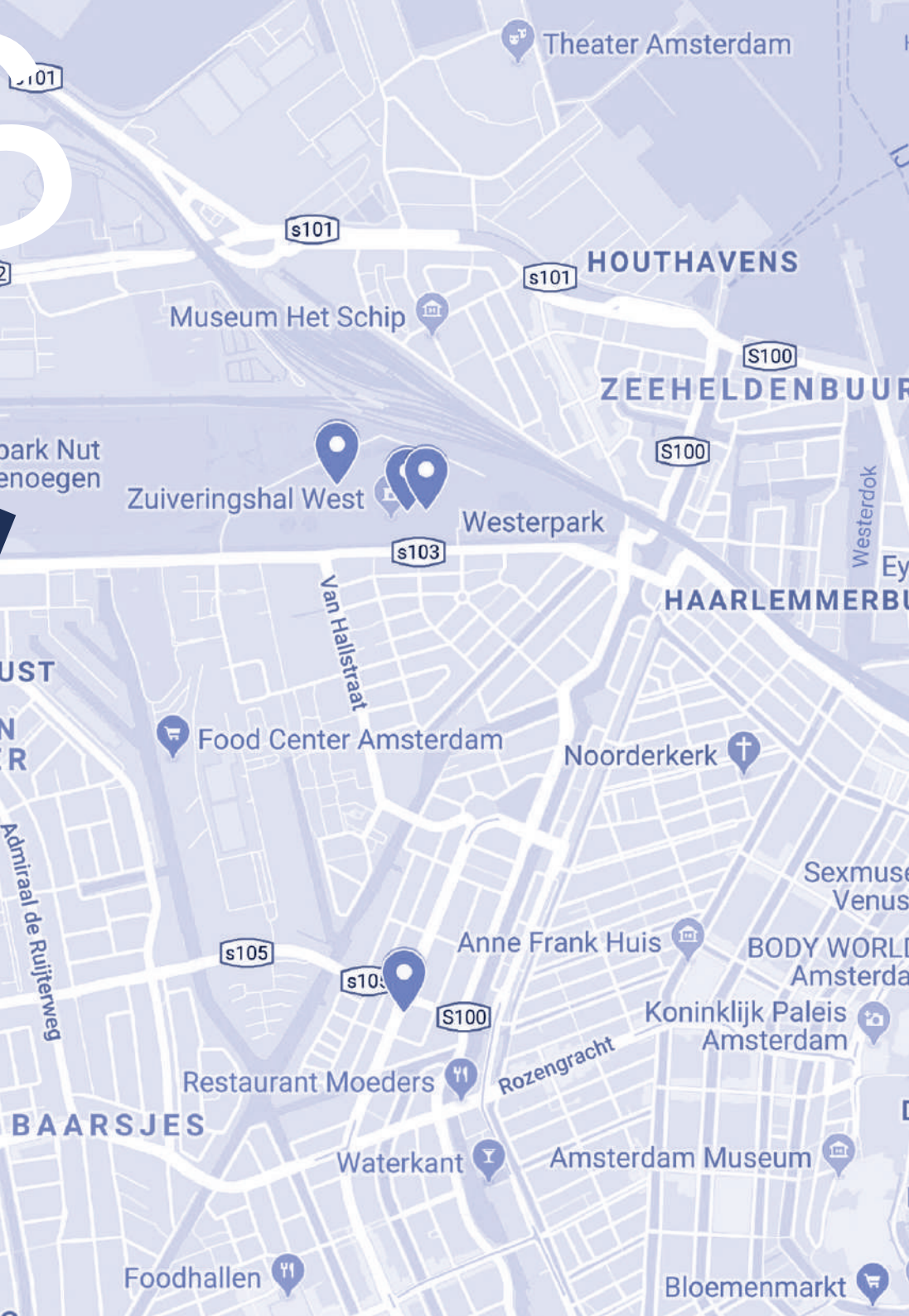

Brand history

Kaboom is the love child of the two biggest animation festivals in the Netherlands: KLIK Amsterdam Animation Festival and Holland Animation Film Festival. In 2019, we realized that our differences could be used to complement each other. We decided to combine our efforts to create a brand-new animation festival that truly has it all. With a big blast, Kaboom was born!

Why the name Kaboom?

There are two sides to an explosion: the blast and the impact. The blast is immediate, tense, in your face. The impact is what comes after: the consequences, the recovery, the reflection. In taking on the name Kaboom, we hope to show that our festival incorporates both sides. We're in your face and reflective. We're playful and smart. We want to have fun and we want to be moved. We like sweet and salty popcorn.

Our visual identity

To create the visual identity of Kaboom, we asked the renowned Dutch communications agency KesselsKramer for help. Together we decided what the most important part of our visual identity should be: typography. In all of our communications, the name Kaboom seems to cause a shockwave that ruffles up the clean, bold letters of the text that accompanies it. This way, we hope to convey that Kaboom has impact. A minimalistic approach to an explosive name.

Our leader

Our first leader was produced by or dear friends at Studio Pupil with the briefing "You have two weeks. What can you animate for us?" The Kaboom slogan "Let animation blow your mind" was the inspiration. The two resulting leaders can be seen at the beginning of every screening at Kaboom. Big thanks to this year's leader creators: Dario van Vree (direction), Jing Yue Zwaan (co-direction, design, animation), Firma Helle Willemstein (sound design) and Tünde Vollenbroek (production).

THE TEST OF TIME ^{75 MIN}

At the primary school De Zandloper, Sam's father Menno is the most boring teacher ever. Trying to spice up his classes, he opens portals to the past with a magical tooth. The greatest historical heroes start visiting the classroom, but then something goes wrong and Menno the teacher gets stuck in history. Sam and his peers Jill and Zuko try to save him with the help of a pirate that's been long forgotten by history.

CAPTAIN MORTEN AND THE SPIDER QUEEN ^{90 MIN}

A young boy learns to take control over his life when he is shrunk to the size of an insect and has to sail his own toy boat through a flooded café. This puppet movie took three years to make, and was developed at the world's oldest functioning stop-motion studio, Nukufilm in Tallinn, Estonia.

MIRAI 105 MIN

Mamoru Hosoda | 98:00 | JP | 2018



A young boy encounters a magical garden which enables him to travel through time and meet his relatives from different eras, with guidance by his younger sister from the future. In 2019 this Japanese adventure fantasy film was nominated for an Academy Award and a Golden Globe, both for Best Animated Film. Will be screened in Japanese with Dutch subtitles at both Kaboom in Amsterdam and Kaboom Kids in Utrecht.

THE WOLF HOUSE 80 MIN

Christobal Leon, Joaquin Cociña | 73:00 | CL | 2018



The Wolf House tells the story of Maria, a young woman who – after escaping a sect of German religious fanatics – takes refuge in a house in southern Chile. Unfortunately, the house transforms into a nightmarish world. A stop-motion feature inspired by Colonia Dignidad, an isolated colony of Germans and Chileans notorious for the internment, torture and murder of dissidents.

FUNAN 90 MIN

Dennis Do | 84:00 | FR, BE, LU | 2018



Funan is the incredibly powerful story of a young mother's fight to save her son and keep her family together in a barbaric time. Set during the Khmer Rouge revolution that plunged Cambodia into horror, Funan is based on the memories of director Denis Do's mother, on whom the main character is based.

TOP 3 55 MIN

Sofie Edvardsson | 44:00 | SE | 2019



Perpetual list-maker Anton falls in love with David, but things start to go awry when Anton realizes that his dreams in life might be in direct opposition to David's. This Swedish romantic comedy from writer Simon Österhof and director Sofie Edvardsson deals with gay love without treating it any different from a regular love story. The film will be preceded by *Bear With Me*, a short animated documentary on immigrants who left their home and crossed borders for love.

THE SWALLOWS OF KABUL 120 MIN

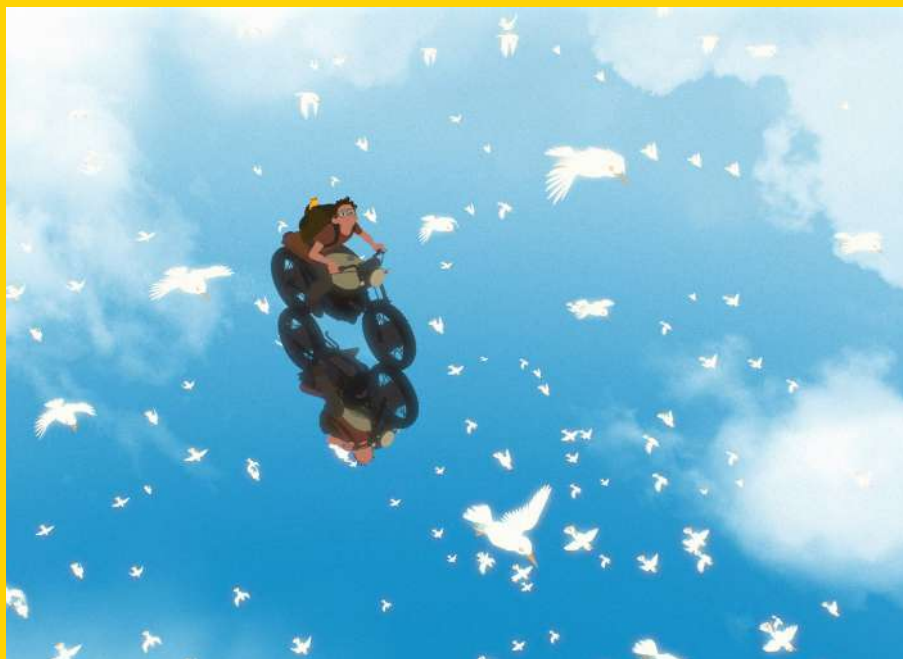
Zabou Breitman, Eléa Gobbé-Mévellec | 80:00 | FR | 2019



Kabul, 1998. Despite the devastating violence of the Taliban occupation, Mohsen and Zunaira are in love and want to believe in a brighter future. Their hopes are dashed when confronted with the realities of their situation. A compelling animated feature about love and courage while being repressed, based on the international bestseller by Yasmina Khadra.

AWAY 90 MIN

Gints Zilbalodis | 75:00 | LV | 2019



A boy and a little bird are traveling across an island on a motorcycle, trying to escape a dark spirit and get back home. Amazingly enough, this award-winning Latvian film was made entirely by just one person, Gints Zilbalodis (1994). It also won the Contrechamp Award at Annecy.

THE STATE AGAINST MANDELA AND THE OTHERS ^{90 MIN}

Nicolas Champeaux, Gilles Porte | 105:00 | FR | 2018



There were no cameras in court when Nelson Mandela and nine other defendants were sentenced to life imprisonment in 1964, but sound recordings were made throughout the trial. Directors Nicolas Champeaux and Gilles Porte recognized the potential of these 256 hours of audio, and used them to create a vivid reflection on the apartheid era. The cross-examinations are illustrated by animation in gray, sometimes abstract charcoal sketches, and accompanied by interviews with the people who were directly involved. Wearing headphones, they relive the notorious Rivonia Trial.

TUX AND FANNY 85 MIN

Albert Birney | 82:00 | US | 2019



Tux and Fanny is a compilation of 79 very creatively animated Instagram shorts. Together they tell the story of two off-the-wall characters and their daily adventures. With his pixelated animation technique, writer and director Albert Birney takes us all back decades ago, to an era when Microsoft Paint was still the highlight of a computer.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND

First of all, Kaboom is very excited to invite you to our themed program about space travel. It's a subject that concerns us all—or at least it most probably will in the future. We will consider space travel from a great variety of angles by showcasing a carefully curated selection of animated work. We'll have a look at the philosophical implications of leaving our precious blue-green marble behind, we'll scream our lungs out at the intergalactic horrors that await us and... we'll try not to get too aroused by

looking at all those tight-fitting space suits.


100 YEARS OF DUTCH ANIMATION

One of the main goals of Kaboom is to nourish the Dutch animation sector and provide it with the international audience it deserves. And what better year for us to put a bright shining spotlight on Dutch animation than 2019. Exactly 100 years after the first known surviving print of animation made in the Netherlands. It was a promotional film for an aviation show in Amsterdam-Noord in 1919 called *A Little Adventure in the Sky*.



To celebrate the rich history of Dutch animation, Kaboom has compiled a set of programs consisting of Dutch animation made between 1919 and 2019. This is a unique chance to see these films in such great quality, so go for it!

FOCUS ON AARDMAN



Then: Aardman. This legendary British powerhouse has been treating us to incredibly successful and astonishingly funny stop-motion clay animation productions for many years now. While Aardman Animations is probably best known for their series of shorter and longer films based on the Wallace and Gromit characters, their animated feature *Chicken Run* (Peter Lord & Nick Park, 2000) ranks as the highest-grossing stop-motion film in the history of forever. And *Wallace & Gromit: The Curse of the Were-Rabbit* (Nick Park & Steve Box, 2005) won the Academy Award for Best Animated Feature and the BAFTA Award for Best British Film.

FOCUS ON SOUTH KOREA

We used to be quite the noobs when it came to the history of South Korean animation: it was like having a very intriguing

stranger in our midst that we wanted to know a whole lot better. That's why we decided to do a deep dive into its sumptuous history. South Korean animation stands out because it displays a perplexing richness of creativity. It is very much its own special thing, and comparing it to cinema from any other country would be like comparing apples and oranges that have been processed into a tasty kimchi.

FOCUS ON ARTISTS

Be sure to check out our Focus on Artists program, where we give artists the spotlight, whether they want it or not. There's a workshop by Steven Woloshen (pioneer of drawn-on-film animation) and master classes by David Sproxton (one of the co-founders of Aardman) and Mike Hollingsworth (of *BoJack Horseman* fame). Why not join Anna Eijsbouts at her *Filmmaker's Talkshow*, where she talks to filmmakers taking part in this year's competition? And on our *Night of Shame*, we'll listen to artists tell us their horror stories about disastrous animation projects.

FOCUS ON COMICS

Finally: let's talk comic books, graphic novels, digital comics and their relation to animation! We'll celebrate the anniversary of Dutch magazine *Zone 5300* and watch shorts and long animated features based on comics. Juicy!

WHITE LINES - 5 YEARS OF GLITTERENDE EENHOORN & LAE



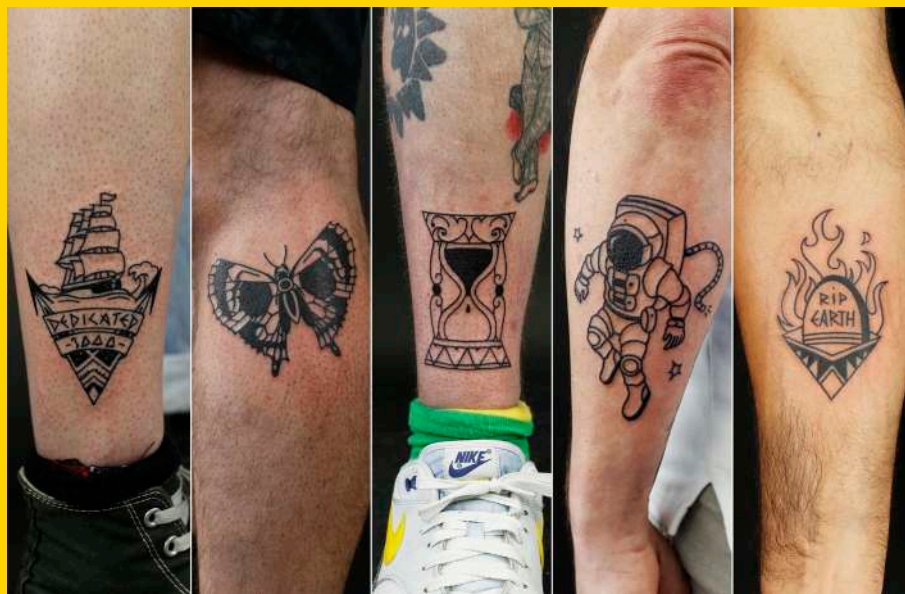

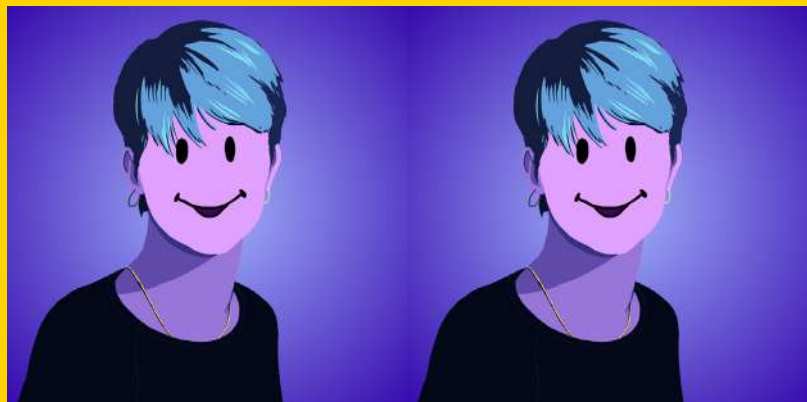
