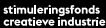

Buses 38 and 105 stop close to the ferry in North Amsterdam (bus stop: Buiksloterwegveer), at a three-minute walking distance from EYE.

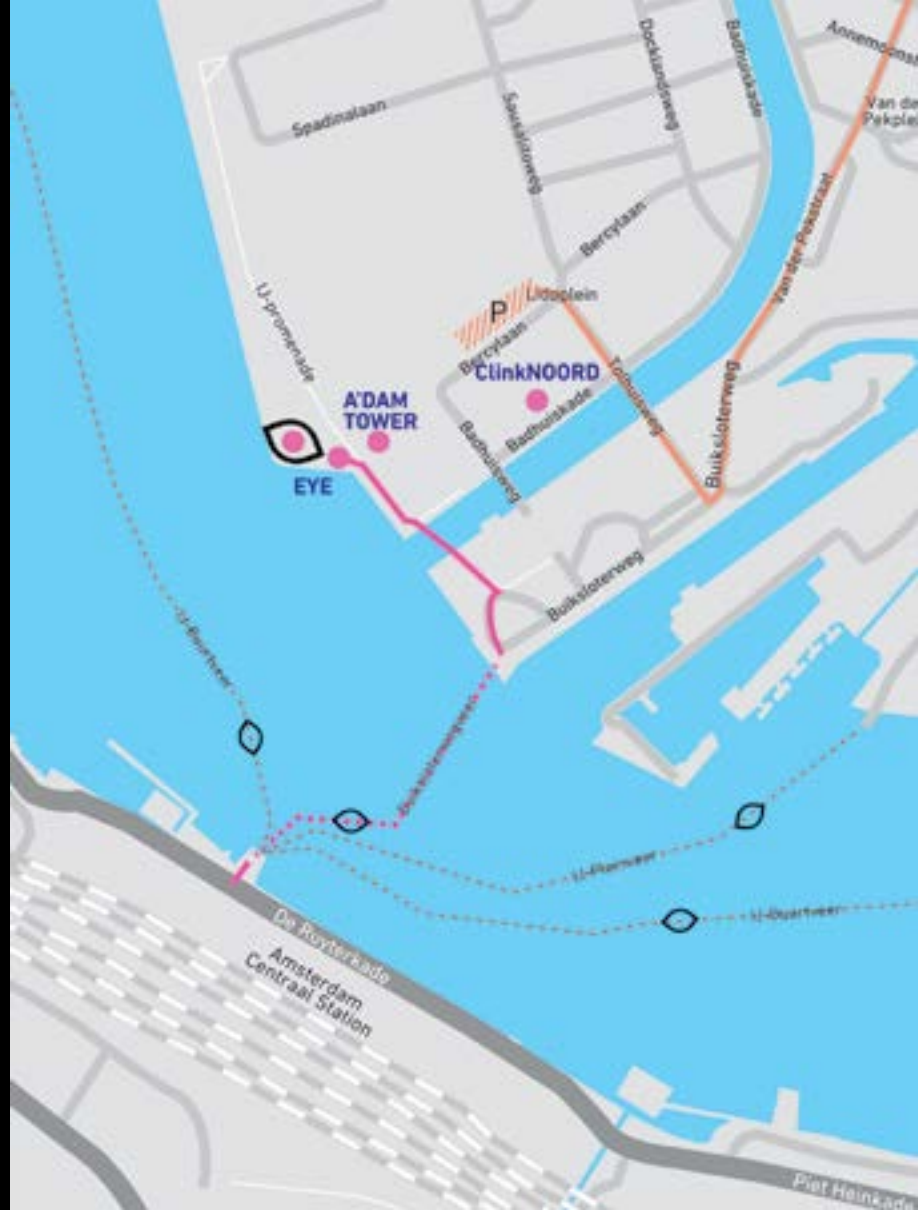
FILMMAKERS HUB

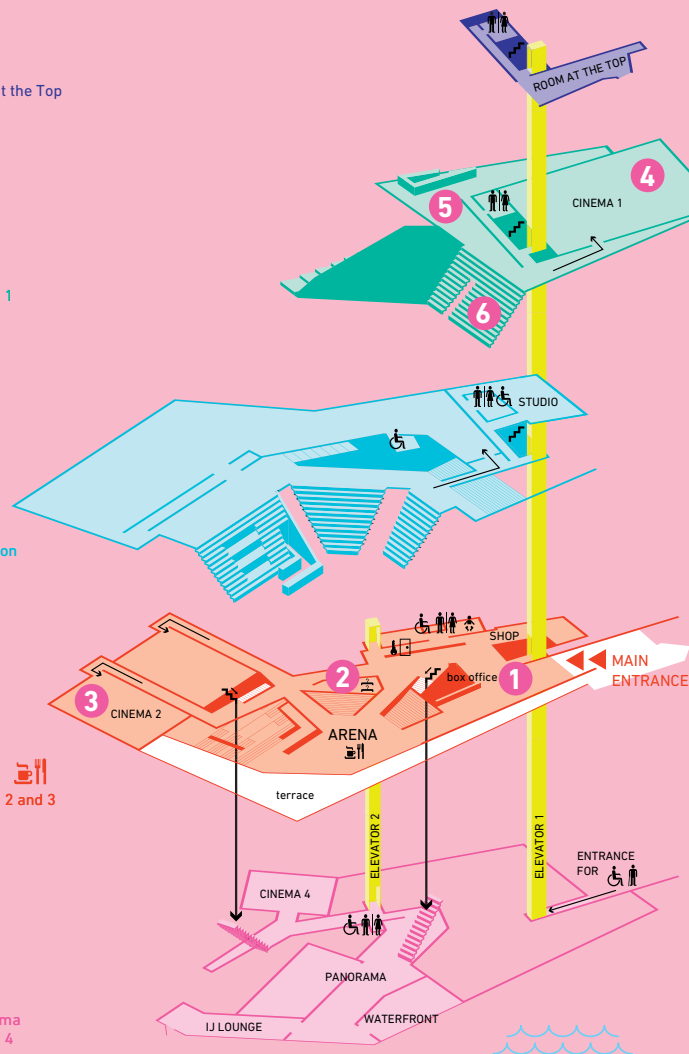

One of KLIK's core values center around our role as facilitator in promoting and connecting Dutch animation talent with the industry both nationally and internationally. MEET MIRJAM DEBETS



This year, we're working with the recently graduated illustrator and animator Mirjam Debets. We love Mirjam's fantastical universe, inhabited by depictions of flora, fauna and other anthropomorphised creatures.

Mirjam is a 2D animator, VJ and illustrator based right here in Amsterdam. As an artist, she experiments with techniques,

Luca Tóth

Luca Tóth is a Hungarian animation director whose first independent short *Superbia* premiered at Critics' Week In Cannes 2016. With a background from the Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design and the Royal College of Art, Tóth is well versed in the world of art, animation and film.



Faiyaz Jafri

Faiyaz Jafri is an experimental multimedia artist, self-taught animator and professor of art at Parsons School of Design in New York. Jafri's work is highly versatile, having exhibited work in the form of print, installation, animation, and sculpture at numerous prestigious festivals and museums across the world.



Clémence Bragard

Clémence Bragard is an audiovisual researcher, programmer and coordinator for the AFCA's National Film Festival in Rennes, the NipponNordic project manager at The Animation Workshop in Denmark, and one of the chairs of the association Les Femmes s'Animent, promoting French women in animation.

DOCUMENTARY JURY



Tom Fassaert

Tom Fassaert is an accomplished filmmaker from The Netherlands who was recently included in Variety's 10 Documakers to watch. His feature length debut documentary *An Angel in Doel* premiered at the Berlinale to critical acclaim, and his second feature *A Family Affair* earned him a Dutch Academy Award. Fassaert also teaches and coaches at (international) film schools and the IDFA Mediafonds workshop.



Niki Padidar

Niki Padidar is a Dutch/Iranian director with a background in photography, having studied at the New School University in New York, the Rietveld art Academy in Amsterdam, the University of Amsterdam, specialising in youth, media and perception. Padidar's debut documentary *NINNOC* won 7 international awards, including best youth documentary at IDFA and a special mention at the Berlinale.



Orwa Nyrabia

Orwa Nyrabia is well known in the documentary world as a producer, festival director, curator and mentor, and is currently the artistic director of IDFA. Hailing from Syria, Nyrabia has a history of social engagement, political activism, and is a powerful voice on the international documentary scene.



KLIK FEATURES

THE BREADWINNER ^{95 MIN}

Based on the award-winning novel of the same name by Deborah Ellis, *The Breadwinner* is a universal story of empowerment and the potential of the imagination to transform one's circumstances. From the celebrated studio Cartoon Saloon, this story of perseverance directed by Nora Twomey and co-produced by Angelina Jolie, earned the Irish studio its third Oscar nod for best animated feature.
